This course offers prospective graduate students a chance to refresh their skills in reading, writing and math. Classes review the GMAT test section by section, with an emphasis on skills review and strategies. Practice tests are also administered. Instruction is geared towards effective and efficient completion of the GMAT Test.

Due to a limited number of instructors, we are only able to run one set of classes at a time. Those classes are held on Thursday evenings for math and Saturday mornings for the verbal section. Because students have varying needs and skills, **the course is divided into two separate sections: verbal and math.** If you are aware of your particular areas of ability, you may enroll in the components separately. If you feel that a review in both areas would be beneficial, please register for both the verbal and the math review components.

Class sizes are kept small to maximize effectiveness. Only a limited number of seats are available. It is also important to note that **registration is on a first come, first serve basis.** Confirmations are sent out by email once the classes have been set, usually one week prior to the beginning of the course.

It is important to remember that this course alone will not guarantee you better test score. We are confident, however, that if each student applies their efforts in accordance with our instructor's direction, they will find the course most beneficial.
